REGULATIONS

Forms



Introduction:

The regulations of IMAF of February 2017 were revised in October 2019.

Due to the cooperation with the Tiger & Dragon Association, the regulations of IMAF were partly adapted to TDA Int'l and extended by individual categories (such as Grappling and Kumite).

Note:

Each competitor is responsible for his own to read and deal with this rules book.

FORMS

Competitors:

All competitors compete in clean, neat and traditional competition clothing.

T-shirts and sweatshirts are not allowed!

T-shirts are to be put in the pants and must not be visible below under the Gi jacket.

Shoes are allowed provided they do not damage the mat surface.

Late entries:

Late entries are excluded as soon as the division is started.

Content of the form:

Traditional forms must not be alerted, but are to run as the form in the textbook! Every change leads to deduction.

Exception: the competitor informs the referee that the form is changed and why this is the case. Possible reasons for this may be health restrictions that do not allow a certain movement and a change in shape on the instructions of the trainer (with justification).

Time-limit:

Each Division hat ein Zeit-Limit von max. 3 Minuten.

Exception: individual traditional Chinese divisions.

Change of division:

Each participant will start in the division corresponding to his grade and age. A change to the next higher category is possible, a change to a lower category is not allowed.

Weapons:

All weapons must be presented to the Referee before the start and will be checked for safety.

Sharp weapons are not allowed.

If a color belt drops the weapon, this leads to a point deduction.

Black belts dropping the weapon will be disqualified.

Music forms:

Music is freely selectable. The competitor is responsible for his music. The presence of a music sysetem is not guaranteed. Whether a music system is available can be inquired in advance by e-mail to the organizer.

In music forms, the form must be adapted to the beat of the music. If this is not the case, this will lead to deduction of points.

Rating:

Evaluates are sequence, movements, positions, strength and technique.

For team forms: additional synchronicity.
