# REGULATIONS

## Rumble



**Introduction:**

The regulations of IMAF of February 2017 were revised in October 2019.

Due to the cooperation with the Tiger & Dragon Association, the regulations of IMAF were partly adapted to TDA Int'l and extended by individual categories (such as Grappling and Kumite).

**Note:**

Each competitor is responsible for his own to read and deal with this rules book.

# RUMBLE

## **General:**

Rumble is a playful competition game for children from 4 years old who are not yet fighting. Playfully, the children should learn to overcome inhibitions before contact with the opponent and to come to the goal through skill, speed and ingenuity. At the same time they should be introduced to competitions and develop winning will and fairness.

## **Classification:**

Boys and girls start together. There is no subdivision by graduation, only by age.

## **Protective equipment:**

Protective equipment is not required. Head protection - also with mask - is allowed.

## **Dress:**

Each competitor wears a Gi or the training clothing with Budo belt that belongs to his sport.

## **Procedure:**

The competitors are called individually. The first one is on the right, the second on the left side of the judge.

On their belts is on both sides and behind a 40 cm long band.

At the command of the referee is the greeting.

At the referee's command, the rivals now try to pull each other's ribbons off and hold them up with their arms outstretched.

As soon as a competitor holds up a volume, the referee stops the contest and the competitors return to the starting position. Now the referee awards the points.

## **VARIANT:**

The fighters can all start at the same time - each against each - in the knockout system until only three are left. These 3 children continue to fight for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. In this variant, each fighter has only 1 band.

The organizer decides at the latest on the day of the tournament which variant will be chosen.

## **Fight time:**

The fight time is 2 minutes.

At equal points there is an extension. Here decides the first point.

If it stays off, the extension will be terminated after one minute.

If there is a tie after the extra time, the referee decides.

## **Premature fight end:**

If a fighter has drawn all 3 bands in accordance with the evaluation, the fight is ended prematurely.

**Rating:**

Each drawn band: 1 point

When the tapes are pulled simultaneously, no points are awarded and the tape is hung back.

**Forbidden actions:**

Holding on to the opponent

Clasping the opponent

Repelling the opponent

Knocking over / sweeping the opponent

Applying techniques

Holding your own tapes

To let yourself fall

Running away

**Warnings and penalties:**

There are admonitions for every forbidden action.

If the admonition is repeated three times, the referee may issue a warning.

In case of a warning, a raffle is taken off the rival.
